It is a not-for-profit membership association established in 2000 to advocate for the interests of private seed companies and promote the advancement of the seed industry in Africa. AFSTA is registered in Kenya as an International Organization and has around 120 members, including 118 seed companies, 27 African national seed trade associations, and more than 44 associate members worldwide.

AFSTA's vision is to ensure that all African farmers have access to quality seed for food security. Its mission is to create the best environment for trade and innovation in quality seed for the benefit of African farmers. AFSTA collaborates with governments and regional economic communities to establish incentive-based regulatory frameworks and policies to facilitate the introduction of new technologies and innovations in the seed sector while creating opportunities for the private sector to supply seeds and related services.

AFSTA supports National Seed Trade Associations through various initiatives, including promoting the trade in quality seeds, advocating for innovation and technology transfer, capacity building in quality seed production, and promoting the movement of quality seeds in Africa.




